

PRIORY SCHOOL ACADEMIC YEAR 2010-11

GCSE RESULTS to date including first A Level results

(MODULES TAKEN NOVEMBER 2010 – MARCH 2011)

NOVEMBER 2010

In November 2010, 19 pupils aged from 13-15 (S3-S4 or Years 9 to 10) sat 54 papers as part of their GCSEs in:

Biology
Chemistry
Physics

A*-A	44	81%
A*-C	54	100%

Biology Paper Units 1a & 1b, and Physics Paper Units 1a & 1b were taken by 4 Year 10 entrants, and all achieved A* or A.

Chemistry Units 1a & 1b were taken by 15 Year 9 entrants (aged 14 or under), and 10 achieved A* on all papers.

JANUARY 2011

In January 2010, 12 pupils aged from 14-18 (S4-6th Form or Years 10 to 13) sat 26 papers as part of their GCSEs in:

Additional Science
Biology
Chemistry
Physics

and A/S or A2 Modules in:

Biology
Business Studies
Mathematics

A	16	62%
A-C	26	100%

Our 6th Form students took 5 papers for their A/S & A2 Modules and passed with 2 As, 2 Bs, and 1 C. These are the first A levels taken by students in the 6th Form at Priory School.

MARCH 2011

In March 2011, 28 pupils aged from 13-16 (S3-S5 or Years 9 to 11) sat 52 papers as part of their GCSEs in:

Biology

Physics

Mathematics High Level

Mathematics Foundation Level

A*-A 27 52%

A*-C 50 96%

Of the 52 papers, 3 were Mathematics Foundation Level and all passed at C, the highest level for Foundation.

NOVEMBER 2010-MARCH 2011

SUMMARY

To date, 32 pupils have taken 132 papers with an overall 98% A*-C pass rate.

Of the 129 Higher or A Level papers where A*-C could be achieved, 67% were A*/A.
